RESEARCH SUMMARY

I aim to ask questions and solve problems related to the pathways underpinning healthy and disordered voice and speech production. I maintain several distinct yet intertwined lines of research. Using gold standard experimental neuroanatomy techniques, I identify the neural substrates underlying cortical control of vocalization in rodents and non-human primates. Engaging a variety of psychophysiological techniques, I probe the relationships between human stress responses, communication behaviors, and various facets of personality and identity. Broadly, all of my research pertains to “mind-voice pathways.” Drawing on my experience as a clinical voice pathologist, I seek to improve the diagnosis and treatment of specific patient populations in all my endeavors. Specifically, I am dedicated to advancing the care of people with “functional” voice and laryngeal breathing disorders, and individuals along the gender spectrum. Finally, I am committed to programmatically maintaining and strengthening a mission of justice, equity, and inclusion in every aspect of my career.
