The first term begins late August and students graduate 2.6 years later in late April. The first 6 terms are comprised of both didactic instruction as well as part-time and full-time clinical experiences. The curriculum concludes with two 15-week terminal clinical educational experiences (Fall-Spring)

We want to make sure our graduates are well prepared to enter the workforce so we complement our didactic education program with a clinical program that includes 40 weeks of full-time clinical education experience. The curriculum is designed to emphasize early and intensive integration of our students into the clinical environment throughout their educational program. Our students begin clinical education during the third term in the program and end with 30 consecutive weeks of clinical education after the didactic plan of study.
