

**Pitt's Sports Medicine (MS) post-professional program offers students a unique learning environment. Situated in a University increasingly recognized as an epicenter for optimizing human performance, students gain exposure to world-renowned experts. All students have access to interactive classes, state of the science research equipment and a personalized learning experience.**

### Program Overview

The [Sports Medicine](#) (SM) concentration leading to a Master of Science degree in Health and Rehabilitation Sciences is a two-year graduate program housed within the Department of Sports Medicine and Nutrition. The SM program has a research focus and provides a core curriculum that is central to injury prevention and the principles by which restoration of function and performance is accomplished. Graduates of the program seek appointments in both clinical, research, and educational settings at colleges and universities, high schools, professional sports, and private sports medicine clinics. Individuals who have successfully completed our program include athletic trainers, bioengineers, and exercise physiologists.

### Curriculum

Thesis and non-thesis tracks are available. Students can personalize their education through electives that may include a Clinical Internship, Teaching Internship, or other courses upon approval.

### Admission

1. **GRE scores are not required**
2. A degree in athletic training, rehabilitation science, exercise science, exercise physiology, health science, kinesiology, biomechanics, or bioengineering is preferred.
3. Minimum GPA of 3.0

5. Personal statement, resume, and 3 letters of recommendation
6. Completed application by January 15 to be considered for tuition scholarships
7. Final deadline of March 15

\*Only one application needed if interested in tuition scholarship positions.
