Association-based: Membership or association are noted for these awards.

| <u>American Speech Language Hearing Association</u> | Scholarships are available for undergraduate seniors and graduate students, including both research and clinical doctoral candidates. Fall 2020 students are eligible. \$5,000 | May 13, 2020 |
| <u>American Speech Language Hearing Association</u> | New Century Scholars Doctoral Scholarship: This program is designed to support strong doctoral candidates who will pursue a teacher-investigator career in an academic environment at the university/college level. \$10,000 | Refer to website for details |
| <u>PixelPlex</u> | The PixelPlex Bi-Annual STEM Scholarship was established to help support and inspire students to pursue further education in the fields of science, technology, engineering and math. \$2,000 awarded for the winning essay. | June 5, 2020 December 5, 2020 |
| <u>American Association of University Women</u> | These fellowships were established in 1970 with a \$25,000 grant from the Max C. Fleischmann Foundation. Initially, they focused on opening doors for women in the fields of law and medicine. Over time, the focus expanded to include science and technology, since the demand for a technologically skilled workforce has grown without proportional representation by women. Award amounts vary beginning at \$5,000 | December 1 annually |
| <u>Comedy Defensive Driving</u> | Since 1989, professional comedians maximize student attention span using humor as a method of education, awareness and content delivery of safe driving practices. Any undergraduate student is eligible; the applicant creates and submits an advertisement for defensive driving. \$1,500 | December 31 annually |
| <u>Dr. Pepper</u> | Dr. Pepper Tuition Giveaway Contest is designed to help student reach their biggest goals. Applicants create a profile on the website and a one-minute video share of an idea for changing the world. | October 1 annually |

Undergraduate students in foster care or orphaned while living in the United States are eligible; U.S. citizenship is not required. \$2,500-\$5,000 | Applications available from January 1 – March 31 annually |
| <u>UNIGO</u> | Through the “Make Me Laugh Scholarship”, applicants have an opportunity to share a real life moment through a 250 word essay. Any undergraduate student is eligible \$1,500 | August 31, 2020 |
| <u>National Potato Council (NPC)</u> | NPC provides a unified voice for the U.S. potato industry on national legislative, regulatory, environmental, and trade issues to promote the increased profitability for growers and greater consumption of potatoes. \$10,000 Graduate students researching the health benefits of potatoes are eligible. | See website for details |
